



The Grand Jury charges:

On or about the 12th day of December, 1975, near Wanblee and in Allen, in Indian Country, in the District of South Dakota, the defendant, Vine Richard Marshall, a/k/a Richard Vine Marshall, a/k/a Dick Marshall, an Indian, willfully, deliberately, maliciously and with premeditation and malice aforethought, did aid and abet in the unlawful killing of Annie Mae Aquash, a/k/a Annie Mae Pictou, wherein she was shot with a firearm, in violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 1111, 1153 and 2.
