
On December 17, 2009, the district court ordered that "the government shall recontact the Denver police department to determine what evidence was gathered by the Denver police and what evidence was destroyed. The government also shall obtain information regarding the Denver police department's investigation of the evidence destruction such as what evidence was retrieved and what was not. The information received by the government from the Denver police department shall be provided to the defendants."
