ORDER


Pending before the Court is the Government's Motion for *In Camera* Review of Witness Materials, Doc. 257. The Court has conducted an *In Camera* review of Exhibits A and B. 3. That Exhibit B will not be furnished to the two Defendants as it has previously been furnished to both Defendants.


